Lynes Creek Bridge

Bridge Strengthening

April 2021

Start of work on the Lynes Creek Bridge, Bicheno from Monday, 26 April 2021

The Department of State Growth is strengthening bridges state-wide to continue to accommodate heavy vehicles.

Strengthening Tasmanian bridges on key routes will retain the existing levels of service for heavy vehicle freight and community access. The Lynes Creek Bridge has been identified as needing an upgrade.

Works will be completed by mid May 2021, weather permitting.

During construction works will be carried out between the hours of **7.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Friday.**

Most of the works will take place underneath the bridge but this may involve the use of machinery, which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of workers and road users. Reduced speed limits will be in place and both lanes will remain open during work hours. Please expect delays of up to 8 minutes.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs.
