Install your BinSpring™ in three simple steps

1 To attach, slide the BinSpring™ between the handle and the side of the bin – the longer arm first so that the short arm sits on the lid and the long arm down the side of the bin.



2 Use your fingers to push the BinSpring™ on to the handle. The coils should sit on the handle.



3 Add the provided cable tie to secure your BinSpring™. Make sure there is enough slack so that the BinSpring™ can hang down if you need to keep your bin lid open.

Waste Collection Process

This product was specifically designed so that it does not need human intervention during the waste collection process.

You do not need to remove the BinSpring™. Due to gravity, once the bin is tipped upside down, this clever device will allow the lid to open and the rubbish to be removed.

When finished, the BinSpring™ will then close the lid and keep it closed.



Removal To remove the BinSpring™, use your thumbs to push the BinSpring™ away from the handle and towards the bin.
